Prior to attending the workshop, the student should:

- 1) Read [TAG conditions](#) at your preferred University to determine initial eligibility;
- 2) Obtain transcripts from ALL previous colleges/universities;
- 3) Log in and create a UC Transfer Admission Planner (TAP) [account](#);
- 4) Complete the [TAG application](#) to the best of your ability — academic history should mirror your transcripts, i.e. show all courses—non-transferable, D's, F's, W's, repeats, etc.; and
- 5) Please be on time for the TAG workshop as the information relayed takes the full class. If you expect to be more than 5 — 10 minutes late, please plan on attending another workshop. Remember to bring your transcripts and have your planned courses for spring 2020 (you may need to meet with your primary academic counselor prior to the workshop).

Please Note:

The TAG workshops are designed for fall 2020 UC transfer applicants

Students applying to the UC fall 2021 and beyond, are encouraged to join the SBCC Transfer Academy (TA) by completing the online TA [orientation](#) this fall.

Exception:

The TAG workshops are not appropriate for UC Berkeley, Los Angeles, and San Diego applicants, as these institutions do not offer a Transfer Admission Guarantee
